

Safety plan for organised flights starting from June 6th, 2020

New parameters

Starting from June 6th, 2020, training practice in all sports is permitted in compliance with a detailed safety plan. All hanggliding activities are herewith included. The federal government stipulates: in all activities where constant close physical contact is required, the operations must be planned in a way where only stable groups with a corresponding participant list can take place. Both the distance of 2 meters lasting longer than 15 minutes or the continuous shortfall of a distance of 2 meters without safety precautions are considered close physical contact. In the case of changing groups (i.e. tandem flights) the federal government strongly recommends wearing a protection mask.

The following 5 rules must be adhered to:

1. Only participate if you are symptom free

You are NOT allowed to participate should you have any symptoms of illness. Stay at home or in isolation and check the further procedure with your general practitioner.

2. Keep your distance

Upon arrival, at the meeting point, during the briefing and upon finishing the activity - in all of these and similar activities, a minimum distance of 2 meters must be maintained and you must still refrain from the traditional handshake, high five and hand clapping. Only in cases where physical contact cannot be avoided, such as adjustments to new equipment, take off check for tandem flights, is this permitted. For transportation to take off, the safety regulations of the company or of the industry apply.

3. Wash your hands thoroughly

Washing your hands is a crucial part of hygiene. Washing or disinfecting your hands with soap before and after the activity, will help protect you and your surroundings.

4. Maintain a list of participants

Close contact must be accounted for upon request of the health authority for the following 14 days thereafter. To simplify contact tracing, the company will maintain a list of participants for all activities. The guide or leader of the activity is responsible for completing and correcting the list and presenting this information to the Corona representative in charge as required (see number 5). The form of the list is optional (Doodle, App, Excel etc).

5. Defining a Corona representative

Every company planning to resume their activities must define a Corona representative. This person is to ensure that the applicable rules and regulations are followed.
